Mayor Herold called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Barb Ettlson, candidate for Winneshiek County Recorder, and Warren Palm, candidate for Winneshiek County Supervisor, District 2 introduced themselves. Both candidates; answered questions, explained their reasons for seeking the position each is running for, their qualifications and what their vision is for the particular office they are seeking.. The election takes place on November 2, 2010.

Ron Franzen presented a sketch of the drawing that will be used for 2010 Rendezvous Medallion. He also gave an update on the progress being made for the 2010 Rendezvous. As part of the planning process the Friends of Fort Atkinson will be contacting the appropriated officials from the IDOT, Winneshiek County, etc. for anything needed in conjunction with Rendezvous.

Glass made a motion to approve the following consent items; June 2, 2010 council minutes, clerk's reports, and the monthly bills, seconded by Bulgren, carried, one absent.

The Council discussed a request for funding from the Northeast Iowa Regional Housing Trust Fund and concluded no extra funds were available to make a donation this fiscal year.

Mayor Herold explained some historical information regarding the Fort Atkinson Community Park property. He noted the City purchased two pieces of land from two different owners for a total cost of \$1,100.00.

The Mayor and Council discussed lettering options for the Fort Atkinson Community Park's sign and also noted there is an old piece of concrete that needs to be removed from the park grounds.

Street surfacing and maintenance was discussed. Due to funding limitations it was decided only necessary street repairs would be made.

Mayor Herold told the Council the City will need to purchase equipment for determining elevation of sewer lines. The equipment cost is estimated to be less than \$300.00.

It was noted there have been various complaints received involving loud noises; loud vehicles, barking dogs, motorcycle/4-wheelers ripping around. If the problem persists, an ordinance to address noise issues may be considered.

Elsbernd made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Schneiter, carried, one absent. Meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
