Elsbernd made a motion introducing **Resolution #242**, a resolution setting impound fees for animals which are impounded, seconded by Glass.

Whereupon the Mayor declared said motion carried and the resolution approved.

The Council discussed the need to remove debris and overgrowth from the dike. The plan is to work on the project during the next couple of months.
