Mayor Herold called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

Tom Bushman, from Bushman Insurance, had an informal discussion with the Mayor and City Council concerning insurance coverage for the Friends of Fort Atkinson organization.

The Council reviewed cost estimates from Bacon Concrete, Concrete Foundations and Wicks Construction, to install concrete on 10th Street between 4th St NW and the railroad tracks and 11th Street between 4th St NW and 5th St NW. Concrete Foundations proposal

Schneider made a motion accepting Concrete Foundation's proposal for 8" of concrete on 10th Street from the railroad tracks to 4th St NW and 6" of concrete on 11th Ave from 4th St NW to 5th St. NW, seconded by Karnik, carried.

Mayor Herold and several members of the Council also acknowledged a request from Floyd and Vernelle Hackman to consider some type of maintenance be done to the street they live on.

If the lift station project qualifies, the City Clerk reported there may be another source of grant funds the City can apply for to help finance the project.

Nuisance issues was a topic for general discussion.

Glass made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Schneider, carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
