Even though we do not have Zoning, they feel we should be able to monitor what is happening better than what is happening now. After much discussion, the Hackman’s pointed out some Ordinances they feel apply, and they state the Mayor has the say in the decision, and asked that we seek legal advice on what we can do. Mayor Herold will call the City Attorney.

NRCS advised we need to have current property owner come in and sign a release form in order to give information to Tom on the land. Schneider made a motion to approve the bid with Global for the appraisal, K. Schmitt seconded. All Aye. Carried.

Tom then discussed the bids for Phase 1 Archeological Investigation, with Bear Creek having the lowest bid at \$10,898.24. Motion was made by K. Schmitt, seconded by Schneider, to approve as presented. All Aye. Carried.

Motion was made by Glass, seconded by K. Schmitt, to approve September 5, 2018 Minutes, Clerk’s Reports, and Monthly Bills as presented. All Aye. Carried.

No permits were received.

Discussed how to proceed with Zoning, as there currently is not any in Fort Atkinson. Herold will call Zahasky to discuss.

Motion to approve Resolution 298 approving the FY17/18 Street Report was made by P. Schmitt, seconded by Schneider. All Aye. Carried.
