The Fort still has their liquor license pending dram shop as they may be changing the LLC, and also Cigarette Permit and deciding whether to continue sales. Motion was made by P. Schmitt, seconded by Glass, to approve once everything is in as required. All Aye. Carried.

Motion was made by Schneiter, seconded by Schroeder, to approve FY19 Transfers. All Aye. Carried.
