Greg Barta took the Library box and Utility Drop box to be sandblasted and painted. He replaced a hydrant by Karnik's. He is down to 6 meters to change out to new meter.

K. Schmitt made a motion to approve the April 22, 2019 Minutes, Clerk's Reports and Monthly Bills. Schroeder seconded. All Aye. Carried.

Herold handed out the Sewer Project cost estimate totaling \$2,377,322. Herold called Iowa DOT and they will vacate their piece of land by the project area. Herold also called the surveyor to order the Acquisition Plat, which is what FEMA requires to release the funds. Still need signed Separation Waivers from Marv Smith and new landowner, and City Attorney will record the documents. Johansen spoke with Speer Financial, Dorsey & Whitney, and Luana Bank to start the paperwork for the loan agreement. They will provide prior to the May 22, 2019 special meeting.

Johansen advised Council we need a minimum of 10 days for the public to review the published notice for the Budget Amendment Public Hearing, and asked for a motion to repost May 7th and hold the Public Hearing on May 22nd at 7pm here at the Community Center. Johansen is discussing with the Calmar Newspaper to follow up on the delays. Schroeder made the motion, P. Schmitt seconded. All Aye. Carried.

Discussed hiring summer help, and motion was made by Schneiter, seconded by K. Schmitt, to offer the position to Kimberly Fischer at \$9.00/hour. All Aye. Carried. Johansen will email her to advise.
