Idea was suggested to install the big concrete blocks Croell carries., but feel it needs to start at the bridge, which would be about 120'. Herold will make some calls. Need to look at dike also, as the water is eating away the bank. Barta advised he has 6 sump pumps left to correct, but has not been going into any houses due to COVID.

Motion was made by K. Schmitt, seconded by Schroeder, to approve June 3, 2020 Council Minutes, June Clerk Reports and Monthly Bills as presented. All Aye. Carried.

Motion was made by K. Schmitt, seconded by Schroeder, to set the Public Hearing for the Environmental Review for September 2nd, 2020 meeting at 7pm at the Community Center. All Aye. Carried.

Herold advised the surveyor will be here soon to look at the property proposed for the 2nd Well Project and will coordinate with Barta and Gerleman.

Due to the budget amendment not getting in the newspaper in May, we need to redo that public hearing. Motion was made by Glass, seconded by K. Schmitt to open the Public Hearing. All Aye. Carried. After no comments or questions, P Schmitt made a motion to close the Public Hearing and Approve the Budget Amendments for FY20. Glass seconded. All Aye. Carried.

Glass asked Council if they were ok with Little League selling popcorn and beverages during the Wednesday band concerts to raise some funds. All were in agreement.

Joyce Barta submitted a building permit. After some discussion, Council would like a letter sent to her to investigate property lines and see if room allows as the code is written, or ask for signoffs from the neighbors to approve.

Driveway Specialist will be coming to look at the tennis court. We received \$4,285 from Winneshiek County Development to resurface.

Discussed Nuisances again. Leuenberger and P. Schmitt volunteered to make a list of code violations and bring to Council.

Next meeting will be August 5, 2020 at 7pm in the Community Center. Motion to adjourn was made by Glass, seconded by Schroeder. All Aye. Carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:57 p.m.
